

Regional EMS Time Out Report

M	Age/Sex, Mechanism or Medical Complaint	Age, Sex (include patient's name for handoff), Mechanism of Injury or Medical Complaint/History
I	Injuries or Inspections	Time of Injury, list injuries head to toe; or Inspections (time of onset, brief medical exam/findings)
S	Vital Signs / Symptoms	Vital Signs: first set and significant changes; include glucose, GCS, spO2, etCO2
T	Treatments	Treatments

Give EMS 30 seconds and you will hear everything you need to know!

- ◇ Receiving Nurse will call “EMS Time Out” when EMS enters the room with the patient.
- ◇ Cardiac, Stroke and Trauma Alert patients will remain on the stretcher during report. (Exception: emergent airway /breathing issues may be addressed prior to MIST report at the discretion of the physician)
- ◇ EMS has **30 seconds** to provide report
- ◇ Nurse will document report on the Regional EMS Time Out Report form.
- ◇ Patient will be moved to the gurney.
- ◇ Patient hand off completed.



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
